Thomas Bremer is a Deputy Commissioner of Maritime Affairs of the Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI) Maritime Administrator (the “Administrator”). Mr. Bremer originally joined the RMI Administrator in May 2013 where he was engaged in ship inspection activities out of Houston, Texas and New York, New York offices, before later moving onto marine investigations out of the Reston, Virginia office in March 2019. Mr. Bremer took a hiatus from the Administrator from late 2016-early 2019 and served as the Corporate Compliance Officer for an international manufacturing firm, managing the Quality, Environment, Health, Safety, and Regulatory Compliance programs for sites throughout the Americas. Mr. Bremer served nearly 10 years in the United States Coast Guard (USCG) prior to joining the Administrator. During his tenure with the USCG, Mr. Bremer was stationed on the USCGC Reliance in the Deck Department, at Activities New York in the Port State Control and Investigations Departments, and at Sector Houston-Galveston in the Inspections Department.

Mr. Bremer is a native of Connecticut. He holds a Master of Science in Environmental Science from Virginia Tech and received his Bachelor of Science in Environmental Studies from the State University of New York.
