Vessel is still awaiting drydock but is elevated enough to conduct hull inspection using shipyard crew boat. Inspected Marine Chemist certificate, all sat. Minor repairs are being conducted to hatch covers and 03 crop and renew longitudinal located in preload tank K and void T. Tank plan and full repair list have been attached as documents to this case. Will return to witness repairs and witness NDT of leg to pad and pad to can connections when vessel gets on drydock.

12MAR20: Conducted verification of repairs, witnessed NDT of legs. Several small stress cracks were discovered and repaired in stern leg connection. Full NDT report is attached in documents of this case. Will return to conduct COI and ISPS.

18MAR20: [REDACTED] arrived at vessel afloat at Conrad DW to conduct COI and ISPS inspection. Met with vessel rep to discuss scope of inspection. Inspected vessel in accordance with 840 OSV job aid and 840 security job aid. ABS was also on scene conducting loadline, SOLAS, and MARPOL exams. Inspected all documents and credentials, all sat. Conducted drills, inspected firefighting and lifesaving, conducted steering test, witnessed CO2 system, and conducted all machinery alarm testing, all sat. Conducted reverse power relay and test of e-gen and e-lighting, all sat. Conducted security audit, all sat. While on scene, discovered the following deficiency:

1: Vessel had been using an unapproved Oil Record Book. Will issue an CG-835. Vessel had corrected themselves on the spot by pulling out the correct Oil Record Book.

In my opinion, this vessel is fit for route and service intended. Issued COI and ISSC.


